Military Honors Provided

- Uniformed members participate forming an appropriate flag line including the American flag with an Honor Guard, a POW/MIA flag, a Service flag of the deceased and often additional flags.
- A Rifle Squad will fire a three round volley three times. The Bugler will then play taps.
- Two flag folders for the casket flag. The two members ceremoniously fold the flag with three spent cartridges placed inside. The remaining rounds are placed inside a velvet bag. Both are then respectfully presented to the designated family member.
- Combatants receive graveside recognition with inverted rifle, bayonet and helmet. For the Navy and Coast Guard, the sounding of Eight Watch Bells.





The founding of the Meriden Veterans Honor Guard was in the Spring of 1996. All members are Honorably Discharged Veterans. Since that date we have performed well over 1800 services for our fallen Veterans.

The Meriden Veterans Honor Guard also often respond to requests to participate in parades, patriotic events, speaking at schools, visiting nursing homes and other civic events.
