FOR: City of Meriden

The purpose of this Addendum is to address RFI's.

Q1 Hey I was wondering if I can get the current rates the city is paying as well as who the current hauler is?

A1 All Waste is the current hauler. We pay \$145/pickup and \$124.20/ton for disposal.

Q2 Also I see the City of Meriden is requesting a container for the mattresses but I believe the city is already enrolled in the mattress recycling program. Please clarify that for me.

A2 The mattress dumpster is for mattresses that are dirty, wet, or otherwise unacceptable for recycling. The container that the City is requesting as part of this bid is for (dirty) or non-recyclable mattresses. If the vendor selected does not require these to be separated out from the rest of the bulky material then this "additional" container may not be necessary.

Proposal Delivery - Proposals may be dropped off prior to November 5, 2024 either in person or by courier service. At this time the City does not have the infrastructure to accept electronic proposals and therefore proposals will only be accepted as directed in the RFP documents.
