The purpose of this Addendum is to respond to/publish the questions received on/before 2025-02-27.

B025-32 Citywide Paving

1. Please confirm this project is a unit price proposal. Article 4 on page 77 mentions lump sum work for all work not covered under unit price work. Please clarify.

Yes, this is a unit price proposal. The sample agreement document on pages 76 – 83 should have included a “SAMPLE” watermark on it. Refer to revised sample document attached. The actual agreement document specifically for this project will be prepared once a bidder is selected.

2. Please make questions asked at the pre-bid available in an addendum.

Addendum #01, which included questions from the pre-bid meeting, was issued on Feb. 12, 2025.

3. Please confirm that driveways do not require new processed aggregate base.

The driveways will only require new processed aggregate base on an “as needed” basis. For example: If some of the existing aggregate base was inadvertently removed during the removal of bituminous driveway apron or if the existing base course needs to be shimmed up to meet ne roadway grades. Any new processed aggregate base required shall be included as part of the S.Y. unit cost of Bituminous Concrete Driveway Aprons

4. Section 21 – Permits: Will the contractor be responsible for obtaining any permits for this project?

No, all City permits are waived for this project.

5. Section 26 – CHRO: What is the total amount of state funding allocated for this project?

The portion of the project that will be State funded is approximately \$660,000. The remainder of the project is funded by City bond funds.

Bid Delivery - Bids may be dropped off prior to March 6, 2025 either in person or by courier service. At this time the City does not have the infrastructure to accept electronic proposals and therefore proposals will only be accepted as directed in the Bid documents.
