Football Return to Action Plan

Fall football for the high school level will have 2 (possibly 3) fields spread over several acres. Each field will be managed as a separate zone. *Mandatory* rules will be in place to assist in keeping players and spectators safe with the goal to help reduce the overall number of interactions.

Plan Highlights

- 1. All players and spectators permitted to watch a game will wear masks at all times.
- 2. Games will be held at Maloney or Platt High Schools (possibly Falcon) to control the number of people and their behavior while in attendance.
- 3. Per State guidelines outdoor event capacity for spectators is 100 total.
- 4. Only player's parents will be in attendance. No siblings allowed!
- 5. The home team shall designate safety monitors to ensure everyone is adhering to the rules established. Those not following rules will be asked to leave the grounds. Persons/organizers may also be subject to fines as defined by the Governor's Executive Order 9C.
- 6. Visiting teams will agree to established rules prior to scheduling the game. The rules will extend to the spectators.
- 7. All players and coaches on the sidelines shall wear masks 100% of the time
- 8. Players in the game will wear either a mask or a football shield that extends over the mouth area.
- 9. All players will wear a mouth guard that promotes safe in and out transfer without touching the piece inserted in the mouth directly.
- 10. At the end of each game players will put on their masks, line up and wave to the opposing team.
- 11. Parents will be mandated to sit 6ft apart by family.
- 12. Parents will be socially distanced and mandated to spread out in designated areas only.
- 13. A full-time Safety Director (volunteers) will be on site to monitor and manage all the rules related to safety at the field.
- 14. There will be no concessions.
- 15. No seeds or gum will be permitted as that encourages spitting.
- 16. Further changes may be implemented due to changing conditions.

Game rules:

- 1. No post game team hand shakes
- 2. Referee will determine who will get the ball first by a socially distanced coin toss.
- 3. Mouth pieces must stay in players mouths at all times except QB's because they need to be able to communicate with the offense.
- 4. All balls will be sanitized after each change of possession.
- 5. All players coming off the field of play must have their hands or gloves sanitized immediately by a designated masked representative.

#1 Rule: if you do not feel well – stay home!
