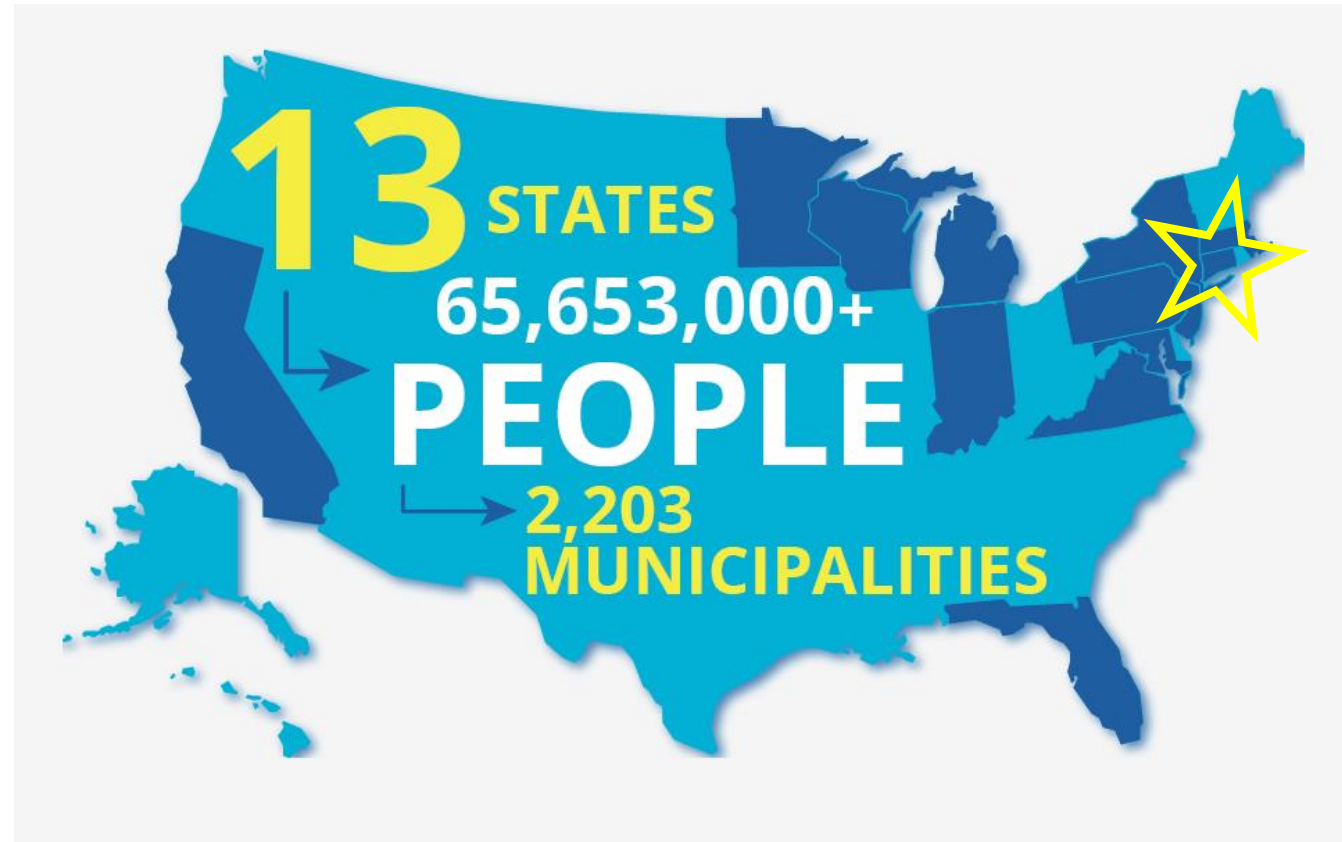

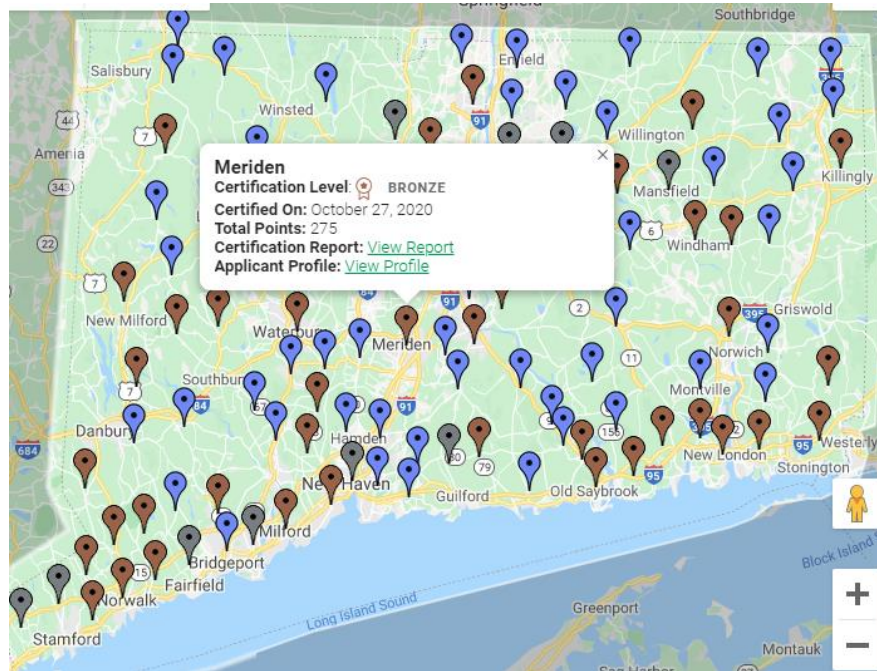

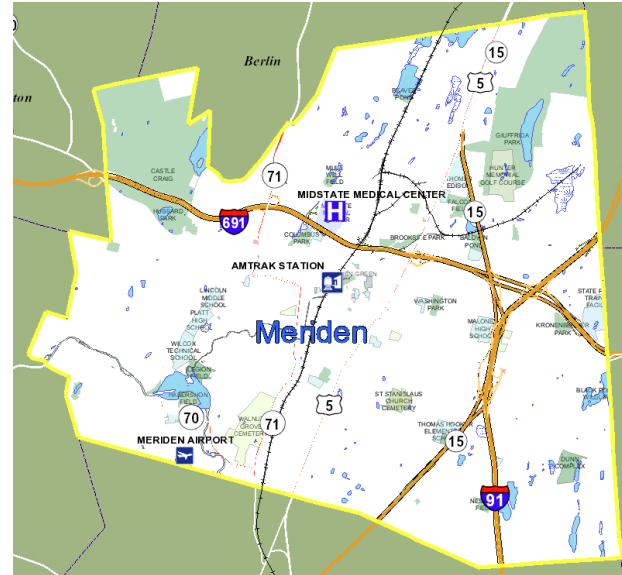




## Sustainable Meriden Internship Program in Cooperation with Sustainable CT
