Title: Food Service Qualified Food Operator (QFO) Requirement

Original Effective Date: July 1, 2003

Revised Date: April 1, 2017

Policy: Food service applicants of a Class III or Class IV establishment must show proof of Certified Food protection Manager (CFPM) prior to licensure.

Purpose: To comply with the Connecticut Public Health Code, Section 19-13-B42

Procedure: Prior to issuing a food service license to a new licensee/owner of a class III or class IV food service facility, the licensee must provide proof that a QFO will be employed in a supervisory capacity and work at the establishment a minimum of 30 hours per week. If the QFO is an employee (non-owner) he or she must fill out and sign "non-owner QFO form" provided by this department.
