School Districts

Guidance from Governor Malloy's Office to School Districts regarding enrollment of displaced children from Puerto Rico:

- District personnel should be counseled to enroll these displaced students immediately, as required by the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act.
- These students will automatically qualify to receive free school meals and must also be provided with health and other related services necessary to ensure their academic success.
- Per established procedures, all students experiencing homelessness must be accurately reported in the statewide Public School Information System (PSIS).
