**REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

**On or about June 17, 2026 the City of Meriden will submit a request to the HUD for the release of CDBG-CV funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to undertake a project known as Hubbard Park Splash Pad for the purpose of improving recreational facilities in the city. The proposed project includes improvements to Hubbard Park through installation of a new Splash Pad. The project includes all associated activities with the installation, including site layout, clearing, demolition, and others. The city is in a high need for improved recreational facilities and this project will assist in meeting this need. This project assists in addressing COVID by preparing more accessible outdoor recreation facilities where social distancing. Open air facilities provide for safer recreational activities.**

## ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

## OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

*HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the City of Meriden's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Meriden; (b) the City of Meriden has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the HUD – Hartford Field Office at [Phillip.e.mckeough@hud.gov](mailto:Phillip.e.mckeough@hud.gov) or*
