Knowledge, Skill and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions applicable to the work.

Considerable knowledge of traffic laws and other regulations governing automotive equipment operation.

Considerable knowledge of the operating and repair characteristics of heavy automotive and similar public works equipment.

Considerable knowledge of the components parts, operating principles, and maintenance needs of maintenance and construction equipment.

Considerable knowledge of the City, including the location and layout of streets and alleys.

Considerable knowledge of the water distribution system (zones, gates, etc.)
