

- Electric Handholes and Manholes that Fall within the Proposed Trail Footprint will Require Resetting
- No Relocation of Overhead Utility Poles or Illumination Poles is Anticipated
- Utility Easements Anticipated for Guy Wires

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## **Constraints and Opportunities**



### Potential Rights-Of-Way Impacts

- Currently, all design features fall within the allowable Right-of-Way
- Construction Rights
  - Right to Grade
- The City will contact property owners if impacts are expected.
- Property Acquisitions will be in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
- CTDOT will be providing oversight of the City's ROW process
- Impacted property owners will receive a written offer of compensation.






