Frequently Asked Questions on Sheds & Garages

Note:

- A BUILDING PERMIT must be obtained for any shed or garage over 200 SF.
- A ZONING PERMIT must be obtained for any shed or garage between 100-200 SF.
- Sheds & garages cannot be used for human habitation, nor for housing of animals or fowl.

Did you know?

Sheds and garages must be kept five (5) feet away from an abutting property owner's property line.

Sheds are not allowed in the front yard.

A shed or garage must be no higher than fifteen (15) feet at the peak. The back yard set-back is five (5) feet and side yard set-backs vary per zone. (Other conditions may apply—contact the Zoning office with questions.)

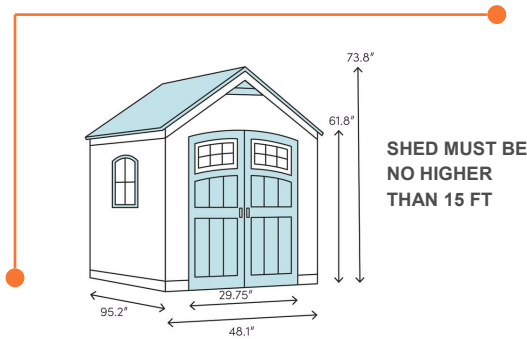
For additional information, please refer to the Code of the City of Meriden, Section 213-48G "Accessory Buildings".

A plot plan that shows the location of the shed or garage with all dimensions clearly marked must be provided with the Building Permit / Zoning Permit application. It is also helpful to submit a photo of the proposed structure.

If you do not know where your property line is, you will have to hire a surveyor to locate your boundaries.

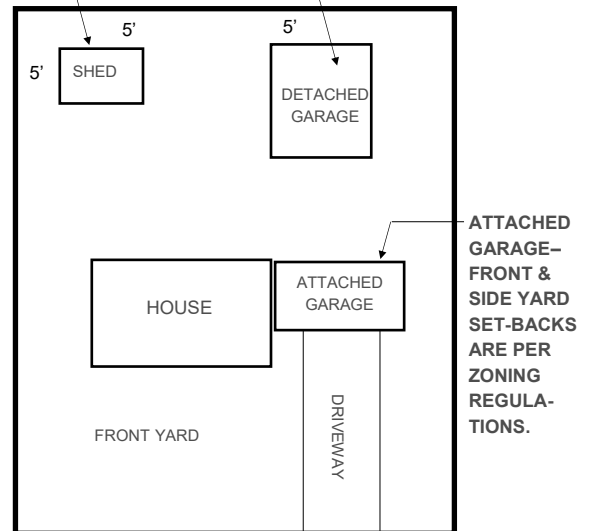
A list of surveyors is available in the Planning office.
