FREE community-based Narcan training and access



This virtual Narcan training is an essential part of overdose prevention education; where members of the Meriden community can learn what an overdose looks like and what to do to reverse them.

Staff will provide training with the intent of empowering community members, opiate drug users, family and friends to save lives. You'll learn about rescue breathing, what Narcan is, how to administer it, Good Samaritan laws, and local resources. **Staff can mail Narcan to anyone who attends and would like a kit.**
